**JURY / SELECTION:** The festival is a juried show by the members of **The North Olmsted Cultural Activities Commission**. The number of arts will be limited and the number of craftsmen in each media will be limited. Entries will be accepted on the basis of presentation and quality.

**ELIGIBILITY:** All arts and crafts will be considered. All work must be original by the artist. Commercial items or kits will not be accepted. **NOTE:** This is a rain or shine event (**NO REFUNDS**).

**DISPLAY SPACE / FEES:** Tent space will be 15' X 15' – **COST PER SPACE IS \$50**, due with application. Make checks payable to **Kiwanis Club of North Olmsted**, please do not send cash.

**APPLICATION PROCEDURES:** Please completely fill out and sign the application. Each exhibitor must submit **3 PHOTOGRAPHS** of their work and a photograph or sketch of their tent and display. Label each photograph with your name and telephone number. Jurying will be done on the first Wednesday of each month on an ongoing basis until all slots are full

**NOTIFICATION:** In order to receive your acceptance or denial along with your photographs you must enclose a self addressed business sized envelope with sufficient postage. One photograph will be kept for our files.

**SPACE ASSIGNMENT:** Directions and other information will be enclosed with your acceptance letter. You will be allowed to set up your tent on Sunday, Aug 8th, 7:00 AM (Ready for business Sun. 10:00 AM).

**SECURITY:** Frostville, and The Kiwanis Club of North Olmsted assume no responsibility for loss or damage. We suggest that you carry your own insurance. Metroparks Police will be present periodically throughout the show

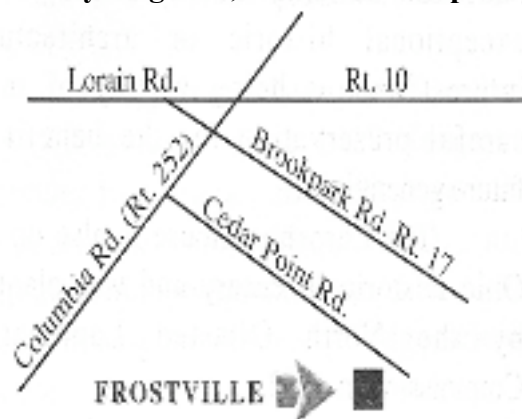
